22/24	<ul> <li>There were four members of the public present.</li> <li>The following matters were raised and will be passed on to the appropriate Telford &amp; Wrekin Council officers: <ul> <li>Trees require pollarding and are very overgrown on the bank adjacent to Albion Street. It was acknowledged that it was not possible to do any pruning or hedge cutting until after the nesting season.</li> <li>Concern was raised about children riding bikes up and down Dukes Way, and also the use of scooters in the road by children and teenagers. It was thought that there was a possibility of injury to the children as well as causing a nuisance to older people living in the area. Further, children are also kicking balls against the garages. These issues will be raised with officers at the Borough Council and a request will be made for the 'No ball games' sign to be repainted.</li> <li>A request was made for the installation of some dropped kerbs in Priorslee Road, Snedshill Way and the surrounding areas of Snedshill because people were finding it difficult to get on and off the pavement safely and that this was a particular issue for disabled residents and for those using mobility scooters.</li> <li>There was a request for a telecommunications box in Snedshill to be painted decoratively similar to the one that has been painted in the centre of St Georges (arranged by Safer Stronger Communities.)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

There has been an issue regarding permissions concerning a wall with a neighbouring property which has caused some delays. a)	Survey of Parish Council trees
	<b>Noted:</b> The results of a survey of Parish Council trees by the Idverde tree officer which did not reveal any safety issues with the trees. One tree is currently being treated for an aphid infestation, but it is expected to make a full recovery. The tree specialist advised, as part of the survey that spruce trees are best suited to acidic soil, which may explain why some of the trees planted around the parish have not thrived.
