Adoption of the Parish Plan 2017/18

Members of the Parish Council were invited to join the Chairman at a Parish Planning workshop on Saturday 29th October 2016. The Parish Council acknowledged the original Parish Engagement Strategy adopted in 2009 was very outdated and a new approach to setting the Councils priorities was needed to help them to consider what are the key areas which the community identify should be reflected in the Councils Parish Plan. The 'Community Listening' consultation work carried out in 2016 by the Citizen Engagement Community Organisers who spoke to over 900 residents has provided the Council with the opportunity to consider the emerging needs of its Parish and demonstrate it is a Council which listens to its Community. It is anticipated that this will become a regular annually held workshop for Council Members to be able to discuss any concerns, be given the opportunity to suggest improvements, agree priorities and create a new plan which will then consequently feed into the budget process.

Resolved: It was agreed the Parish Council will adopt the Parish Plan 2017/18.

Purchase of Secure Safe

As previously agreed with Council, the Clerk has received the following quote from UK Safemoves (Telford based Company) to provide the Parish Council with a Secure Safe.

Gower Street Building

Cllr Lee Carter, Cabinet Member for Finance for Telford & Wrekin Council has provided the following breakdown in response to the Parish Councils request regarding the funding earmarked for the Gower Street Building.

Below is the list of budgets set aside and grants awarded to Heritage Group together with expenditure.

- £650,000 Refurbishment budget
- £22,403 Park/Play area grant
- £17,800 fence/gates at front grant

Of the £650,000 to date £59,303 has been spent which mainly covers the roof to protect the building (£38,500) plus other expenditure in preparing the bid, skips for the clear ups and the ongoing rental of the security shutters. Of the other two grants nothing has yet been spent. Other minor expenditure by TWC is;

- November 2014 £200 towards the running of the group
- September 2015 £150 to hire a JCB for external clean up
- June 2016 £200 for the Gower Partnership Summer Festival

Telford & Wrekin Council have committed nearly £10k of officer time to date to these projects mainly in Building Surveyor and the BiT Team Service Delivery Manager time. This does not include any time spent by Rachael Jones (SDM) and the Community Participation Team. The Clerk has received an invitation from Cllr Carter requesting she represent the Parish Council at future meetings of the Gower Group. These take place on a monthly basis and offers to provide the Clerk with an insight into the general direction of travel of the projects. They generally last for about an hour.

Resolved: It was agreed the Clerk should attend future Gower Group Meetings and keep the Parish Council updated on a regular basis.

St Georges Partnership

At the meeting held in October members of the Group agreed to adopt a new Constitution, and have formally elected Cllr Richard Overton to continue as Chairman, Stephen Handley as Treasurer. The Parish Council have previously supported the Partnership by agreeing the Parish Clerk carries out the role of Secretary.

Resolved: It was agreed the Clerk should continue her role as Secretary to the group on a temporary basis.

Cllr T Hoof expressed an interest in being a member of the Partnership. It was generally felt that the Parish Council were already well represented at the meetings, however it was agreed that should Cllr Hoof wish to be a member in his capacity as a local resident Council has no objection to him formally contacting the Chairman with this request.

Freeston Avenue Play Area

Telford & Wrekin Council Parks & Open Spaces Department have forwarded the findings of the Freeston Avenue Play Area RoSPA report completed in October 2016, the full report is available from the Clerk but in summary the overall risk management scoring is 'Medium' and therefore requires us to ensure the recommendations for improvements need to be completed as soon as possible. The Clerk is liaising with Telford & Wrekin Officer Phil Pritchard from Environmental Services to identify the most cost effective and appropriate company to carry out the repairs. Resolved: The Clerk to procure the necessary work through Telford & Wrekin Council to ensure the repairs are carried out and is fully compliant to RoSPA's recommendations

Clerk related matters

Society of Local Council Clerks

The annual membership renewal is now due at a cost of £157. The Regional Training Seminar planned to be held on 1st February in Telford is on offer up to 10th January 2017 at a reduced rate of £59 + VAT

Publications

The current Parish Councils publication –the Clerks Manual is outdated. The Clerk has been advised to purchase the publication – 'Arnold Baker on Local Council Administration', it is a complete statement of the law relating to parish and community councils now in its tenth edition, this remains the key text for Parish Councils, Local Authorities and solicitors practising in local government law and public/administration law at a cost of £92.

Resolved: It was agreed the Clerk will renew the Membership & attendance at the Regional Seminar for SLCC and to also purchase a new copy of the Clerks Guide.
