63/64 Public Questions

The following matters were raised and will be passed on to the appropriate Telford & Wrekin Council officers:

- Thanks were expressed for the planting of the flower beds which are looking very nice but also regret that they were not re-planted at the same time as the new flower bed at Priorslee.
- It was raised that although the hedge had been trimmed in Albion Bank so that people can walk along the footway more easily, the trees had not been 'topped' at the same time. The member of the public was advised by the operative on site that this type of pruning (topping) is no longer carried out. The Chairman advised that it is the Tree Officer at the Borough Council who makes any decision about reducing the height of trees and that he would send another email to the Team and will report back.
- A discussion arose concerning Traffic Regulation Orders that were being implemented across the Borough and that these were yet to be received for St Georges.
- A member of the public wanted to raise awareness of ongoing issues in St Georges Ward West to include dropped kerbs near the bus shelter on Priorslee Road. She also made a suggestion for the installation of double bins in specific locations because a number of waste bins in the parish are overflowing at times. The Chairman advised that comments are best made by residents on such matters via the Borough Council's website or app. In this instance, this could result in a change to the schedule of emptying a bin in any particular location and would help easily identify the specific locations of overflowing bins.
- Concern was raised over minutes not being taken at site visits and at Working Group meetings, in the context of the subsequent publishing of such meeting Notes and minutes to ensure that the Parish Council is able to keep parishioners up to date with their work. It was requested that minutes of these meetings and other Working Groups are published on the website in order to improve transparency. The Chairman agreed that a Note of the Gower Working Group and Christmas Lights Working Group meetings would be published on the website. These are the two Working Groups currently meeting and it was noted that the Staffing Committee minutes would not be published.
- Member of public wanted to raise awareness of the potential sale of private land for housing development at Greenfields Farm and also raised concerns about Highway matters concerning an 'in – road' from Telford Way.
- Suggestions made about dog poo and that dog owners could be encouraged to pick up others' dog poo when they have spare bags. Bags are available from the Parish Centre.
