Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday **19th March 2024** commencing at 7pm at The School Hall, St Georges C of E Primary School, London Road, St Georges.

Welcome from the Chair: The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Members agreed that they would make any other declarations if they arose during the meeting.

<u>158/24 Public session</u>: 15 minutes is allowed for members of the public to raise their concerns. There were six members of the public present.

The following matters were raised:

- Residents raised concerns about the amount of litter that could be found along Stafford Street, especially around the Co-op shop.
- Concerns were raised about the amount of dog fowling around the Durant Road / Ivor Thomas Road area. Residents also suggested that some of the school children's hand drawn dog fouling posters could be installed. Cllr R. Overton advised that there was due to be a big campaign on Dog Fowling and that Neighbourhood Enforcement Officers could fine people who were not carrying poo bags while out walking their dog.
- A resident shared with the Council an incident regarding her grandson falling into the Lake at Priorslee. The resident had to get into the lake in order to rescue the toddler, but then struggled to get back out again. A passing dog walker was able to assist in getting out. Thankfully the toddler was okay, but the issue has raised concerns over the safety of the pedestrian bridges at the lake where the accident happened.

164/24 Environment/Public Realm:

(a) Community Action Team Enforcement Report – The team have been hitting problem areas of parking such as Redhill Primary School and Wyndham Grove.

(b) Community Action Team Public Realm – The team have been carrying on with their normal program of works as well as specific tasks such as removing lichen and moss from the benches near Teece Drive Skate Park.

165/24 Gower Project: The monthly catch up with TWC had taken place in which the parish are updated on the refurbishment of the building. Items to note included the first floor going up on some of the properties. Additional screening for residents at the rear of the site and the redundant stormwater storage tank being emptied but filling back up again with all the recent rain. The offsite gas connection was due to commence, however they are unable to locate the gas main. Further investigation is needed. The Parish working group met a few weeks ago to discuss how we would like to see the building being used, whether that is for local clubs and groups such as fitness, youth provision, playgroups, coffee mornings etc. It is hoped that with a bigger building we will be able to provide more activities. The Parish Council is keen to hear the views and thoughts of local residents regarding activities being held in the Gower, so if there is anything you want to see please let us know. Other areas that the working group are looking into include furniture, recruitment, terms & conditions, and how other buildings operate.

166/24 Policy Review:

(a) Members Allowances & Expenses Policy

Resolved to adopt the members allowances & expenses policy.

(b) Reserve Forces Training & Mobilisation Policy

Resolved to adopt the Reserve Forces Training & Mobilisation Policy with slight amendments to change the word company to St Georges & Priorslee Parish Council.

(c) Financial Regulations

167/24 Health & Safety:

(a) Safety at the Flash - Council to discuss following the recent incident. The Chairman read out the response from TWC who had commissioned a report from the Royal Live Saving Society (RLSS) which found TWC were not negligent in any duty of care to the public with signage, lifesaving equipment or infrastructure.

Resolved to liaise with TWC on costings and options for further safety measures.

Discussion was had regarding fishermen trampling reed beds and flowers and constant damage to gates onto lake along the west side near to Wordsworth Way.

Resolved to speak to TWC regarding this.

(b) Concerns over air quality around Red Hill – Update from TWC Environmental Health.

The update from TWC was read out. Once the Parish Council receives more information, we will update our website.

(b) Priorslee Clock Proposed Footpath – The Council were still waiting for further quotes for the footpath to come in.

(c) Flower beds in St Georges Square – The Council was still waiting response from Lakeside Garden Centre about updating the planting.
