Free Lawn Mowing Service Terms and Conditions

St Georges and Priorslee Parish Council offer a Free Lawn Mowing Service which is open to residents of the Parish who are:

- 70 years of age **or**
- In receipt of Disability Benefits and are unable to manage the mowing of their lawn themselves **and** have no help from family members **or**
- Veterans/members of the Armed Forces **or**
- Care leavers.

The service is a basic lawn cut. Lawns should be free of animal waste and grass cuttings will need to be disposed of in the resident's green bin. The Service aims to provide 10 x cuts a year starting in April and running through to September. The lawn cutting can take place in both front or back gardens if required, and if time allows. The gardener will only be able to spend a maximum of 1 hour at each property, each visit.

The Service will be advertised via the Noticeboards, Facebook and on the Council Website. Residents are encouraged to apply for an application form as soon as they become available and will be assessed and places allocated based on eligibility criteria. There are 30 spaces available.

Where there are no further spaces available, applications are put onto a waiting list. Throughout the year as enquiries into the gardening service come in, these will be placed onto the waiting list. If residents take themselves off the list, we will contact the next person in line to see if they would like the service.
