**Update on project:** Work progressing well with an estimated completion date of November, this has slipped back due to issues with the roof. The refurbished Bell tower has been delivered, and chimney repairs progressing along with celling insulation and plastering. There is now a BT connection on site and TWC communication team working with local school children to create a time

capsule. The Gower working group met to discuss topics including feedback from the surveyor on electrical installation and procurement and how to move forward with quotes for these specialist installations, room hire, booking systems and migrating the current user groups across to the new building.
