183/25 Gower Project:

Update on project: the bell tower is now in position and following various tests the conservation officer is happy for pointing to be carried out on the walls. Chimney repairs are progressing and there is now a BT connection onto the site. TWC's comms team will be working on the time capsule with local school children. Items that the Parish Council will be

procuring have started to be sourced.

184/25 Community Projects & Events:

- (a) Report from the Community Projects & Events Officer: The Great British Spring Clean took place on Saturday 5th April in Priorslee and Gatcombe Way with the next event scheduled for 7th May in St Georges. Warm Up Wednesday will continue until 21st May and the St George's Day event will be held on 21st April. Volunteer application forms are now available for those who would like to lend a hand at groups and events. Knit & Natter and Veterans' Group continue to run successfully and ticket sales for the Barmouth trip are going well with three coaches being full but spaces still available on the remaining two coaches.
- **(b) Update on the VE Celebrations:** Two benches have been commissioned with the unveiling planned for Thursday 8th May. The St Georges Event at Marrions Hill will start at 10am and the Priorslee event will begin at 1:30pm. Performances will be given from all three of the local primary schools and light refreshments will be served along with cake.

185/25 Council to consider the Telford & Wrekin Council documents:

After considering the Local plan the following comments were made to TWC:

HO26 Land South of Old Vicarage: - There was recent correspondence from the diocese (Landowner) to say that the land had been confirmed as grazing land for the foreseeable future. Recommendation that the site needs verification from the owner that the land will cease to be grazing land & allowable for development

SC2 Land North East of Muxton: -The 'SUE' (Sustainable Urban Extension) proposed at the land north east of Muxton has a sizable number of properties and as our parish links this site to the M54 and A5, as well as the town centre, there could be a considerable increase in traffic movements and our concerns are that the infrastructure plan does not meet the needs that will be required to take this volume of traffic. Recommendation that an investment in the highways of Redhill Way, Castle Farm Way, St Georges Bypass & the A5 is required.
